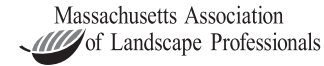

From Mass Pike: Exit from the Mass Pike at exit 13. After the tollbooths, bear right onto Route 30 West, towards Framingham. Follow Route 30 to the third set of lights. Take a left hand turn; at the stop sign take a right. Follow the road to the end; at the light take a right onto Route 9 West. IMMEDIATELY take a right into Ken's Steak House parking lot.

From Route 128 North/South: Exit for Route 9 West (2 exits south of the Mass Pike). Follow Route 9 West through Wellesley and Natick. Ken's is on the right after Shopper's World.
